Approval of November meeting minutes

PAC Room

- Chris spent some time cleaning up the PAC room and getting rid of rat faeces

- We will need to set a budget for storage bins so that we keep things organised and rodent free

Financial

- Hot lunch in and out which is approximately \$850

- Committed funds:

 - Grad Fees \$3600
 - Bursaries \$1500

Hot Lunch

- Things are going smoothly and we have a great team of volunteers
- Chris will contact Munch-a-lunch to get reports so that we can figure out how much money we actually have in our account
- We might need to review our prices for Hot Lunch and make sure we are making enough profit - possible price increase in the new year
- There were a few complaints about Wendy's burgers and items being cold. It's hard to keep the food warm when we need to pick up the food and sort it before lunchtime
- We will need to relook at Wendy's as a vendor once the term ends in March

- Hot dog day is our most profitable hot lunch
- Our payout is approximately 85%

Staff Christmas Party

- Saturday in the gym at 5pm
- The staff are decorating themselves
- We need to collect and scrape the dishes, clean up the decor/tables/chairs
- Sandie is the PAC lead on this and will contact Mrs. Huculak

Christmas Concert

- Krystal will be the contact between PAC and Kamloops Full Gospel
- We will be serving cookies and hot chocolate only after the evening performance
- We will figure out the logistics later this week

Bursaries

- Every year PAC hands out a Missions (\$500) and an Academic (\$500 - with proof of enrollment) Bursary
- Students need to apply for these bursaries however, overall there are few applicants who apply
- Years ago, Terry (past CEO) started a Student Leadership Bursary. One year this switched to a Trades Bursary but then switched back.
- This year PAC would like to add a Trades bursary for \$500
- This year these funds will come out of the Gaming Account - next year out of the General Account.

Parent Ambassador & Class Rep

- Chris will put out a formal request for parents to sign up to be a Class Rep for all classes Kindergarten - Grade 12

Raffle

- This year our raffle profits will go towards team jerseys and gym equipment
- Donations so far: 2 Kayaks/ BBQ /Canucks Tickets
- Sandie has let us know that she cannot head up the Raffle Committee
- Krystal and Nora will go out and hand out letters to get donations
 - Ideas: patio set, life jackets, Costco GC
- At this point we won't be putting a donation request on the app because there are too many fundraisers happening at this time

Coffee Fundraiser Update

- We ran into a few hiccups with the link not being linked on social media
- The fundraiser went ok - we raised approximately \$535
- It was not good timing - as there were too many fundraisers happening around the same time
- We do plan to try this fundraiser again but at a different time of the year
- The company was easy to work with - however may consider doing online orders only next year

Cultural Room

- Extra funding for the rug was approved via our PAC Facebook group. The total amount approved was \$515.19
- Karen picked up the \$180 cost from her budget for furnishing the room

Tool Sharpening Tool

- As talked about in our previous meeting, the sharpening tool will cost \$2460.50
- Chris asked Trevor what would happen if we only covered part of the cost... Trevor said that he'd need at least 80% of the cost covered or he wouldn't be able to fund his portion of it
