Goal of PAC:

New Business:

Mr. Osborne Memorial Project:

- Mr. Osborne passed away this past summer from cancer. (He taught mostly Middle School and also coached high school basketball)
- The students have had the opportunity to write down a memory on a memory board
- The students are looking into making a Memory Book with pictures for his family.
- The students will be doing The Terry Fox Run on September 15 in memory of Mr. Osborne

PAC is wanting to contribute/donate something in his memory

- Mr. Osborne was a music teacher and he loved ukuleles
 - We could purchase a special ukulele to hang up in the music room with a plaque
 - We could purchase new ukuleles if there was a need for additional ones
 - We could pay to get the existing ukuleles re-strung and tuned up
- Mr. Osborne was also a coach
 - We could put a patch or a memento on the high school basketball jerseys
 - We could replace the basketball backboards and nets on the blacktop

We will move this to the October Meeting and put it to a vote

PAC Representatives:

- We are aiming to have a PAC Rep for each class
- This will help us communicate with teachers and parents
- They would be the liaison between the PAC and the class
- They would communicate the teacher's needs, keep an eye on student dynamics, bring forward any issues etc...
- We had most grades represented in this first meeting - all grades except for Grade 12

Gaga Pit:

- Chris has been overseeing this project
- We plan to have this project completed this week!
- The rubber mats are installed, lumber will be cut today, and staining will happen this week (tomorrow during school hours)
- It doesn't seem like gaga balls will need to be purchased as they have a bin of balls available for students during recess and lunch
- The playground rep is coming to the school next week - Chris will show him the Gaga Pits as well as the playground and get his thoughts/input

New Project Idea:

- Refacing the basketball hoops on the blacktop
- They look sad and the bolts on the base of the poles are unsafe
- The hoops are used constantly
- This might be great as an 'in memory of Mr. Osborne' project

Committee Formations:

Hot Lunch:

- This is a fundraiser as well as a convenience for families
- Hot lunch brings in approximately \$3000 each year
- Heather has figured out the cost and the schedule for restaurants
- Hot lunch is every Tuesday and Thursday
- We hope to start on October 4
- We need a Hot Lunch Coordinator as well as a team of people to commit each week
- The coordinator would schedule volunteers, place orders and do purchasing
- Petra has expressed interest in becoming the coordinator
- Amy and Kim cannot commit as much this year - they are willing to train others
- Jen is willing to fill in when needed

Treasurer's Report:

- The General Account is used for things like the grandparent's tea, teacher requests, feminine hygiene products etc...
