Old Business:

Raffle:

Indigenous space behind the Foods Room:

- We have contacted Mrs. Kay to see what the needs are and are awaiting her response
- The space will be a student space
- We are unable to supply paint and furniture for the space however we can help out with things like an indigenous mural or a hand carved piece

9 - Square in the Air:

- Not ordered yet
- Chris has sent an email to Karren and is still awaiting a reply
 - What is the goal?
 - Who will set up and take down each day as it cannot be left outside permanently
- \$1300 for the portable structure
- \$7500 for a permanent structure

Playground:

- Chris contacted the playground company and received two \$100,000 quotes for playground equipment - not quite what we asked for so Chris will contact them again
- We are hoping there is a way to reconfigure our existing structure and add pieces to it to make it accessible for everyone
- Rubber resurfacing for the playground would be about \$37,000 - this would not include the swing area

Gaga Pit:

- If we decide to resurface the playground we should do the gaga pit at the same time
- Chris will get a quote for resurfacing just the gaga pit area and will look into the KalTire bursary which opens every January
- The gaga pit is currently closed to students because it's so muddy
- A second gaga pit would be nice - one for the elementary and one for middle school
- There are permanent gaga pit structures available at some companies - Chris will look into some canadian companies

New Business:

Plant Fundraiser:

- This fundraiser will go towards the resurfacing the Gaga Pit - hopefully this will bring some excitement for the students to want to raise some money

- One cheque will be made from the PAC to the school for the fees we are covering
