Grad Fees:

Grad fees are \$350 per student

Teacher Requests:

Teachers can make requests from PAC for supplies

Mrs. Huculuk(Grade 2/3) spends approximately \$40 a month on prizes for reading. PAC has agreed to give her \$120 for year. Voted all in favour

Tammy Koester (IIP Teacher) has already purchased an interactive board to help non-verbal students communicate with teachers. Cost was \$166 - PAC agrees to pay that cost.

Mrs. Johannesson has requested money for her reading program. PAC has agreed to give her \$120 for the year. Voted all in favour

Financial Report:

- \$6000 left to exchange for lockers
We need to keep \$2000 - \$3000 in the account for the hot lunch program
Sandie applied for a government grant (\$6000) which can be used for programs like 'come read with me'/ bursaries etc. These funds cannot be used for capitol.
We are still awaiting approval from the government

Fundraising:

Coupon Book Fundraiser is happening now until November 15

Raffle will happen in March 2022

Plant Sale: usually happens in the Spring

We make the order forms, and pre-sell sausages

option 2: selling via catalogue. we earn 25% of profits

Spring Raffle:

As of yet, we do not have any prizes that have been offered from the KCS community

Need to write a letter to give to businesses to ask for donations/discounts

There is no database of families who have their own businesses in the school

After the raffle wraps up, PAC will send thank you cards to the businesses who've participated - suggested for each PAC member to sign

The donation button on Munch a Lunch is working really well. \$200 has been donated so far. We will let the teachers know that there are funds available if they notice students that need/want hot lunch
